2010 Outdoor Rifle League

Bring your .22 pump, lever, bolt, semi-auto, Ruger 10/22 Space Gun and / or your center fire carbine (M1 Carbines are allowed) and try it out. Chapter membership is not required.

Matches will be held on the second Wednesday of each month. The dates are April 14th, May 12th, June 9th, July 14th, August 11th, September 8th, and October 13th. Start time is 4:30 P. M. at the pistol range.

We fire the NRA National Gallery course which is ten rounds slow fire (10 rounds in ten minutes) on a NRA B2 target, ten rounds timed fire (5 rounds in 20 seconds, two times) and ten rounds rapid fire (5 rounds in 10 seconds, two times) on NRA B3 targets. We do this once for a total of 30 rounds (a maximum score of 300).

For bolt action rifles that hold at least five rounds, the timed-fire time is increased from 20 seconds to 30 seconds and the rapid-fire time is increased from 10 seconds to 20 seconds. Other rifles, which hold less than five rounds, will be given extra time as determined by match experience.

You may shoot any combination of the following categories multiple times per match. **A person may shoot one additional time within the same category in a match and the best score will be kept for that category. If this best score is not to your satisfaction, it must be kept, even if caused by equipment malfunction.**

- Rim fire; "iron" sights at 25 yards.
- Rim fire; any type of sight at 50 yards.
- Center fire; "iron" sights at 25 yards.
- Center fire; any type of sight at 50 yards.

Center fire is limited to what would be considered a pistol cartridge. For example, 38 Special, .357 magnum, 9 mm, 41 Special, 44 magnum, 45 ACP, 45 Colt, etc.

The rifle must be held off-hand (no external support); slings are allowed. Eye and ear protection is required. Cost is \$1.50 per category for targets and awards. You must shoot in a minimum of three matches in a category to qualify for an end-of-season award and for awards to be given there must be at least two qualifying shooters in that category. Averages will be kept to three decimal places. Match results will be published.
